

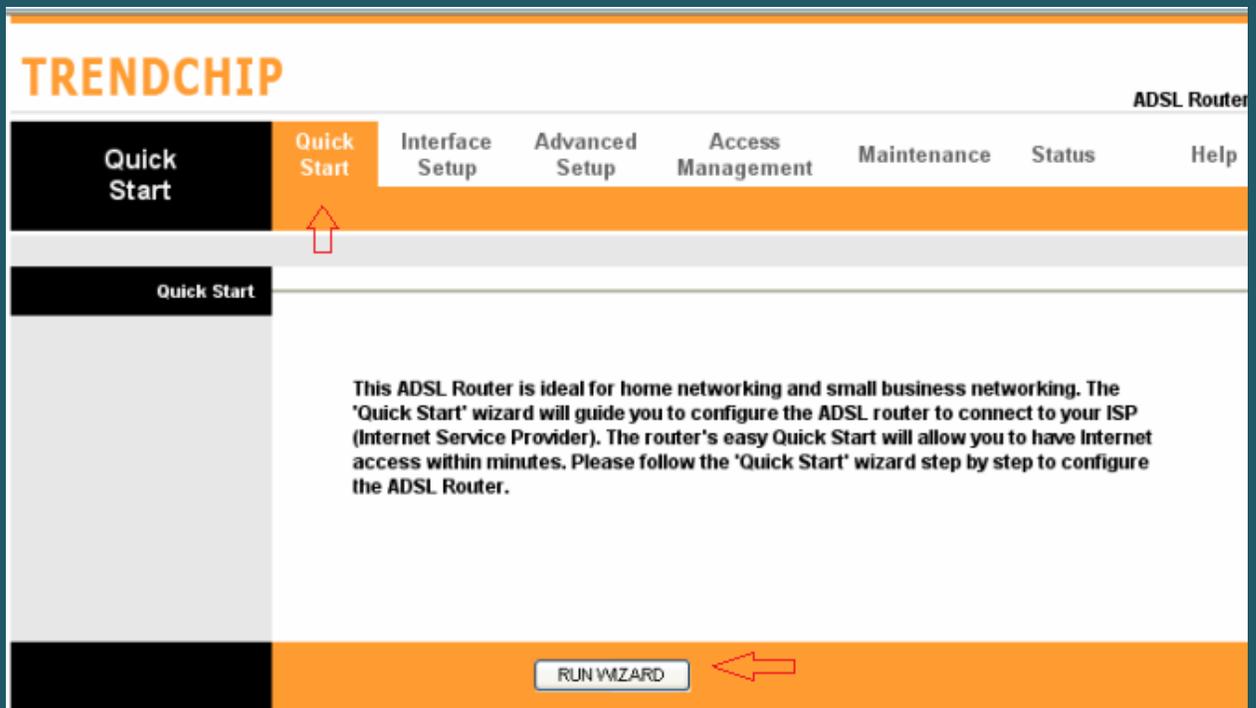
## Justec JDR454WV4

Please follow the below steps to configure Justec JDR454WV4 modem

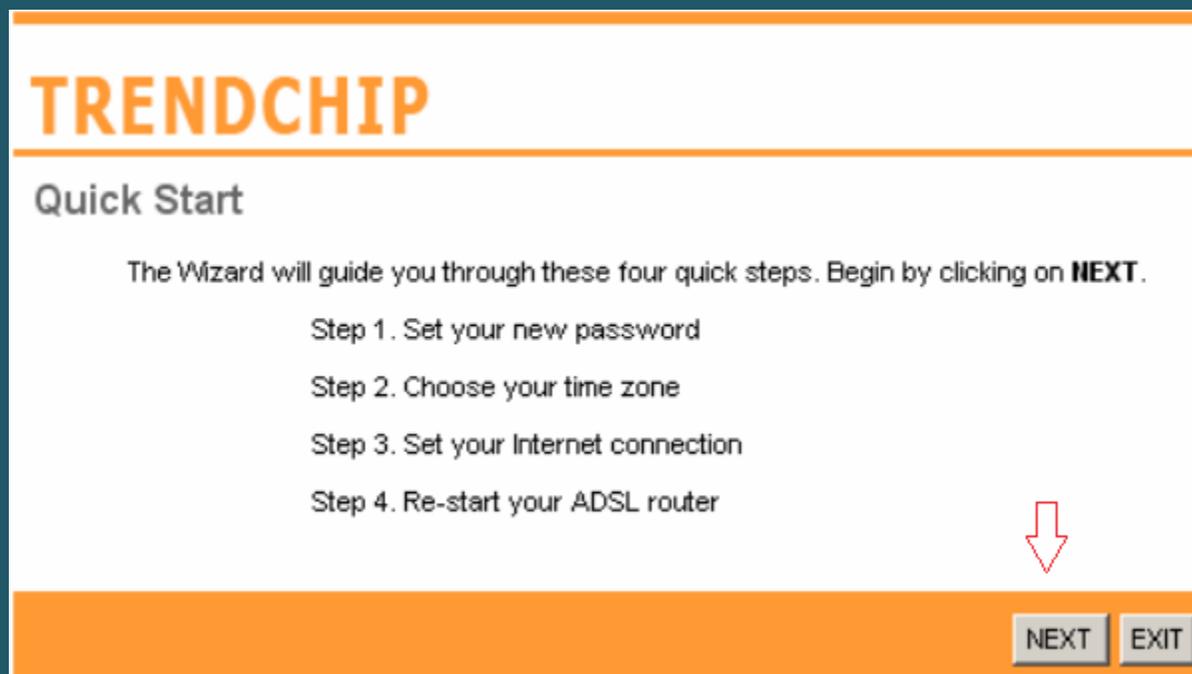
- Establish a connection between the device and the router via network cable or Wi-Fi (default WIFI password is simply written on the bottom of the router. If you turn the router over, you should see a sticker, and one of the pieces of information should say something like “Wi-Fi Password” or “WPA passcode.”)
- Open a browser and type 192.168.1.1 in the address bar
- You will be prompted to enter Username admin and Password 1234



- Click "Quick Start" to get into the quick setup procedure then RUN WIZARD



- When You see Wizard Steps click Next



- We prefer to keep default Administrator password to access modem and you can change it from 1234 to admin then click Next

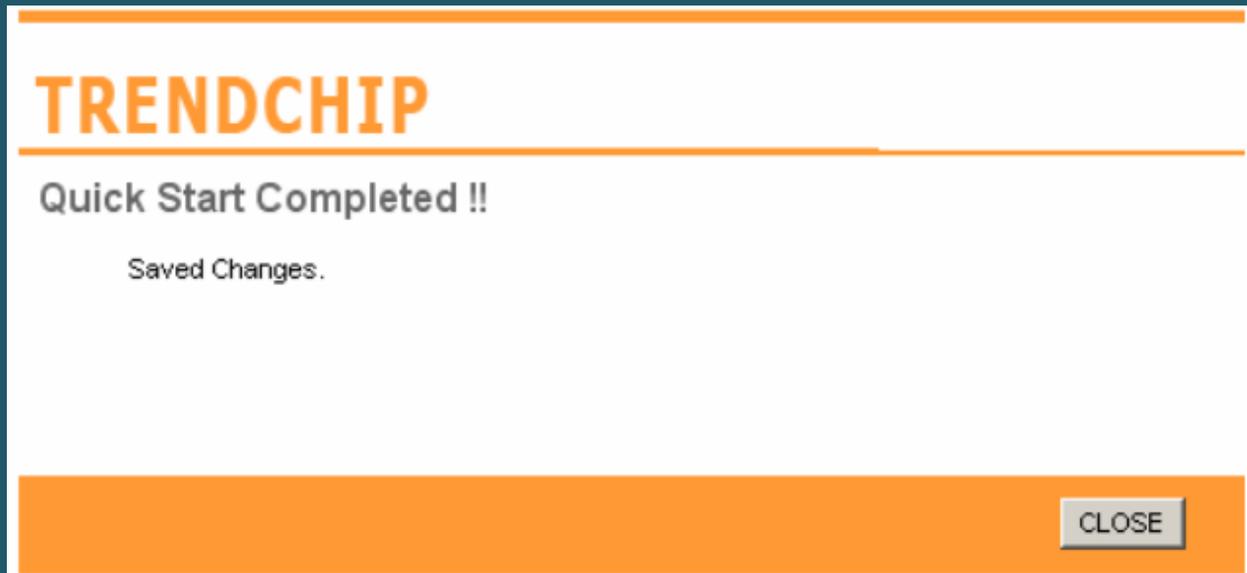
## Quick Start Complete !!

- In Pre-Shared Key type wireless password (safest passwords are long and contain at least 8 digits of mixed letters, and number)
